RESOLVE

In relation to Public Records of Parishes, Towns and Counties.

1 *Resolved*, That the commissioner appointed under the
2 provisions of chapter sixty-five of the resolves of eigh-
3 teen hundred and eighty-four, relating to public records
4 of parishes, towns and counties, is hereby authorized to
5 expend a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dol-
6 lars, being in addition to the sum authorized by chapter
7 nine, resolves of the present year, for completing the
8 collection, compilation and tabulation of the information
9 relating to such records; and from the amount hereby
10 authorized the said commissioner shall be allowed, on
11 the completion of his report, and in full compensation for
12 his services in connection therewith, the sum of one
13 thousand dollars.
