RESOLVE

Relative to the Safety of Railroad Employees.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the Board of Railroad Commissioners
- 2 is hereby instructed to investigate whether any legis-
- 3 lation is required to promote the safety of trackmen or
- 4 other employees of railroads when at work upon the
- 5 road-bed, and to report to the next General Court the
- 6 results of their investigation, with such recommendations
- 7 and suggestions as may seem to them expedient.
