MassRMV, EOPSS Release Video for Parents of Teenage Drivers

The Executive Office of Public Safety and Security (EOPSS) in partnership with the Massachusetts Department of Transportation Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV) today unveiled an educational video for parents to help them prepare their teens to become safe, smart drivers.

"Tips for Parents, A Common Sense Guide to Keeping Your Teen Safe Behind The Wheel," includes solemn words from the parents of a teen killed in a crash and will be provided to driver education schools to be shown at the required class for parents and caregivers of young people getting their Junior Operator's License. Motor vehicle crashes are the number one killer of teens in the nation, with inexperience cited as the leading cause. Crash rates are highest among teens during their first few hundred miles on the road; new drivers are four times more likely to be killed and 14 times more likely to be injured than any other group.
