

MassDOT, Boston Harbor Now Present Proposed Ferry Site Short List to Seaport Economic Council

Members of the Seaport Economic Council were briefed on a dozen sites which have been identified by stakeholders as having the best potential for new or expanded ferry service. As part of the ongoing Boston Harbor Water Transportation Study, routes between these sites will then be analyzed to select the three routes most likely to have financially sustainable service.

RMV: More Customers Eligible for Online Transactions



The Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV) is taking steps to allow more customers the opportunity to renew a driver's license or ID card online. The RMV has extended the length of time a customer can use a license photo from 9 years to 14 years which means more customers than ever are eligible for online renewals.

In addition, customers will be eligible to renew their licenses or ID cards online for two consecutive renewal periods.
