**Governor Charlie Baker's Schedule for Tuesday, January 16, 2018**

**BOSTON** – Tomorrow, Governor Charlie Baker will participate in the ribbon cutting ceremony for the Accenture Innovation Hub. Later, he will join Boston Mayor Martin Walsh and Cardinal Sean O’Malley to participate in the groundbreaking ceremony for The Union, a project that will add 46 units of affordable housing in Boston’s Chinatown neighborhood.

After that, the Governor and Secretary of Health and Human Services Marylou Sudders will testify at a hearing of the Joint Committee on Mental Health and Substance Abuse in support of the administration’s second significant package to fight the opioid and heroin epidemic, including legislation titled *“An act relative to Combatting addiction, Accessing treatment, Reducing prescriptions and Enhancing prevention”* (CARE Act).
