AN ACT

In addition to “an Act to alter and amend the Consti-
tution of the Board of Overseers of Harvard College.”

1 SEC. 1. **BE** *it enacted by the Senate and House*
2 *of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by*
3 *the authority of the same,* That whenever any vacancy
4 shall hereafter happen or arise, in the clerical part of
5 the Board of Overseers of Harvard College, the
6 Board in filling such vacancy, agreeably to the pro-
7 visions of the Statute to which this is in addition,
8 may elect any stated Minister of a Church of Christ,
9 ordained agreeably to the usages of the order to
10 which he may belong; *provided,* that when any Min-
11 ister so elected shall cease to have the ministerial
12 relation he had at the time of his election, or shall
13 remove out of the Commonwealth, the place of such

14 Minister at said Board, shall thereupon become va-
15 cant.

1 SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That this Act shall
2 be in force when the Overseers of Harvard College,
3 and the President and Fellows of Harvard College,
4 shall accept the provisions of the same.
