### AN ACT

To Incorporate the Worcester House Company.

1    SEC. 1.    **BE** *it enacted by the Senate and House*  
2 *of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and*  
3 *by the authority of the same, That David T. Brig-*  
4 *ham, George T. Rice, Joseph G. Kendall, their as-*  
5 *sociates, successors and assigns, be and they hereby*  
6 *are made a Corporation, by the name of Worcester*  
7 *House Company, for the purpose of purchasing,*  
8 *holding, erecting and managing a suitable and com-*  
9 *modious house of entertainment, and its appropriate*  
10 *appurtenances in the town of Worcester, and may*  
11 *enjoy all the powers and privileges, and shall be*  
12 *subject to all the duties and requirements contained*

13 in the eighty-third chapter of the statutes of eighteen  
14 hundred and thirty-three, entitled "An act concern-  
15 ing Corporations."

1 SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That said Corpo-  
2 ration be and hereby is authorised, to purchase and  
3 hold such real and personal estate as may be neces-  
4 sary or convenient for providing a commodious and  
5 convenient house of entertainment with the appro-  
6 priate grounds, stables and out buildings for the  
7 same, near the termination of the Boston and Wor-  
8 cester Rail Road in Worcester ; provided however,  
9 that the whole amount of said real and personal es-  
10 tate together, shall not exceed one hundred thousand  
11 dollars.

1 SEC. 3. *Be it further enacted*, That whenever any  
2 action shall be commenced against said Corporation,  
3 whereon judgment shall be rendered, and execution  
4 issued, if said Corporation shall not before the day  
5 on which said execution is returnable, after demand  
6 made upon the President, Treasurer or Clerk of said  
7 Corporation, by the officer to whom said execution  
8 has been committed to be served, show to said officer  
9 sufficient real or personal estate to satisfy said exe-  
10 cution, or any sum or sums due thereon, then upon  
11 such neglect and default upon the issuing of an alias  
12 execution, the officer to whom said execution may  
13 be committed for service, may serve, and levy the  
14 same upon the real and personal estate of any indi-  
15 vidual who was a member of said Corporation at the  
16 time when the debt or debts accrued upon which  
17 such execution may have been issued.

1   SEC. 4. *Be it further enacted,* That said Corpo-  
2 ration shall enjoy any privileges, and be subject to  
3 any duties and requirements which may be conferred  
4 or imposed upon like Corporations by any general  
5 law which may hereafter be enacted.
