### AN ACT

Increasing the Salary of the Attorney General.

1    SEC. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House*  
2 *of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and*  
3 *by the authority of the same, That the salary of the*  
4 *Attorney General of this Commonwealth shall be*  
5 *eighteen hundred dollars annually; and the same*  
6 *shall be paid him from the Treasury of this Com-*  
7 *monwealth quarter-yearly; and he shall account to*  
8 *the Treasurer of the Commonwealth for all fees,*  
9 *costs and money received by him in virtue of his*  
10 *office.*

1    SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted, That all acts and*  
2 *parts of acts inconsistent with this act be, and the*  
3 *same are hereby repealed.*

1    SEC. 3. *Be it further enacted, That this act shall*  
2 *take effect from and after*
