HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, JAN. 14, 1836.

*Ordered,* That the Committee on Banks and Banking, inquire into the expediency of establishing a Bank with a specie capital of six to ten millions dollars, one half to be subscribed for by the State, payable in Scrip of the State, bearing a low rate of interest, redeemable in twenty years. The other half to be owned by individuals—and that the Committee report by bill or otherwise.
