TREASURY OFFICE, (2d mo.) Feb. 6th, 1836.

To the Honorable House of Representatives.

“The aggregate amount of money received into the Treasury for taxes, on the several Banking Corporations within the Commonwealth, since the first establishment of any such corporation,” is three million, six hundred and forty thousand nine hundred and fifty-three dollars, forty-two cents—(\$3,640,953 42.)

“The lawful interest on the sums so received,” to the first of February instant, calculated from the average dates on which the respective semi-annual taxes were paid in amounts to the sum of one million, nine hundred and sixty-seven thousand, six hundred and fifty-six dollars, fifty-six cents—(\$1,967,656 56.)

The above has been prepared in compliance with an order of the House of Representatives, dated January 30th, 1836, and is respectfully submitted.
