AN ACT

Concerning the Election of County Commissioners and
County Treasurers.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECT. 1. The time for the election of county
2 commissioners, special commissioners, and county
3 treasurers, in each of the counties, except Suf-
4 folk and Nantucket, shall be on the second Mon-
5 day of November, of this and every third year,
6 hereafter; and the time of meeting of the board
7 of examiners in said counties, for the purpose of
8 examining the returns of votes for said commis-
9 sioners, shall be on the first Tuesday succeeding the
10 third Monday of November, in each year in which
11 there is an election of said commissioners.

1 SECT. 2. The said commissioners and treasurers
2 shall hold their respective offices, for the term of
3 three years, from the first Monday of February next
4 succeeding the time herein provided for their election,
5 and until others are chosen and qualified in their
6 places.

1 SECT. 3. The county commissioners, special com-
2 missioners, and county treasurers, now in office in
3 said counties, shall continue to hold their respective
4 offices, until the first Monday of February in the
5 year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, and
6 until others are chosen and qualified in their places.

1 SECT. 4. All the provisions of the fourteenth
2 chapter of the Revised Statutes, and all acts and parts
3 of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act,
4 are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 5 This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
