AN ACT

To provide further penalties for wilfully and maliciously obstructing the passing of carriages upon Railroads.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 Any person convicted of any of the offences set
2 forth in the seventy-seventh section, of the thirty-ninth
3 chapter of the Revised Statutes, which endangers
4 human life, may be punished in the manner set forth
5 in said section, or by imprisonment in the State Prison
6 not exceeding twenty years.
