AN ACT

Concerning Notifications of Creditors of Insolvent Estates.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

- 1 That at all meetings of creditors of insolvent
- 2 estates, except the first, personal or written notice
- 3 need not be given to the creditors, unless thereto
- 4 specially required, by an order of the commissioner of
- 5 insolvency, before whom the case is pending.

AN ACT

to provide for the collection of duties on imports

and to amend the laws relating to the same

That all the duties on imports of goods and merchandise shall be levied and collected in accordance with the provisions of this act, and the same shall be paid to the collector of the port to which the goods are imported, and the collector shall be authorized to issue receipts for the same, and the same shall be valid in all courts of law and equity.
