RESOLVE

On the Petition of the Overseers of the Poor, of the Town of Ipswich.

Resolved, for reasons set forth in said petition, that there be paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to the treasurer of the town of Ipswich, the sum of one hundred and forty-one dollars and forty-eight cents, in full discharge of the account of said town, for attendance and supplies rendered, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, to certain persons, non-residents within the state, sick with the small-pox; and that a warrant be drawn accordingly.
