RESOLVE

Relating to the Fall River Indians.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid, out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to Holder Wordell, guardian of the Fall River Indians, the sum of two hundred and fourteen dollars and sixty-six cents, being for the balance of said guardian's account, approved by the judge of probate for the county of Bristol, on the fourth day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight.
