RESOLVE

On the Petition of the Town of Oxford.

Resolved, That there be reserved, out of the present year's income of the school fund, for the benefit of the town of Oxford, a sum equal to what the town would have received from the income of the same, for the last year, if the returns of the town had been duly signed by all the members of the school committee, according to the requirements of the statute; and that the sum so reserved be added to the share, if any, to which said town of Oxford may be entitled, in the present year's income of said fund.
