RESOLVE

In favor of the County of Norfolk.

Resolved, for reasons set forth in said petition, that there be allowed and paid, out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to the treasurer of the county of Norfolk, the sum of two hundred and seventy-three dollars and ninety-three cents, in full for the support of William Broadbent, an insane state pauper, to December thirty-first, eighteen hundred and forty-seven; and that a warrant be drawn therefor accordingly.
