### AN ACT

Respecting Sales by Executors and Administrators.

*BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :*

1   SECT. 1. Any real estate held by an executor or  
2 administrator in mortgage, or taken in execution,  
3 may be sold (at any time before the right of redemp-  
4 tion is foreclosed,) in the same manner as the per-  
5 sonal estate of a deceased person may be sold by an  
6 executor or administrator.

2 EXECUTORS AND ADMINISTRATORS. [March, 1849.]

1 SECT. 2. That portion of the fourteenth section  
2 of chapter sixty-fifth of the Revised Statutes, which  
3 is inconsistent with the foregoing provision, is hereby  
4 repealed.
