### RESOLVE

For the Erection of Fountains in front of the State House, and repairing the Bank Wall.

*Resolved*, That the Sergeant-at-Arms, under the direction of a committee, to consist of the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and Chairman of the Committee on Public Buildings, cause fountains to be erected, in the State House yard, in such manner as they shall deem advisable, and cause the bank wall to be repaired.

*Resolved*, That the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars be, and the same is, hereby appropriated, for the purpose of carrying into effect the foregoing Resolve, which sum, or such parts thereof as may be necessary, shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of an act, entitled "An Act relating to the State House," passed the eighteenth day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-one.
