The Joint Special Committee, to whom was referred the report of the Valuation Committee and accompanying papers, under an order of Jan. 22d., have attended to that duty, and

REPORT:

That they have *carefully* examined the same, and they find many errors in the castings and additions, all of which they have corrected. These several alterations vary the aggregates of sundry towns, but in no case have the committee altered the county aggregates of polls and property.

The counties of Suffolk, Hampshire, Berkshire, Norfolk, Bristol, Barnstable, Nantucket and Duke's, are reported without alteration, (see Valuation Report.)

In the counties of Middlesex, Essex, Worcester, Hampden, Franklin and Plymouth, corrections have been made in several of the towns, which vary the aggregates thereof, and the committee herewith report them in a corrected form.

IN SENATE, Feb. 13th, 1841. Accepted—it being first *Ordered*, that \$70,000 be deducted from the aggregate of the town of Pawtucket, in the county of Bristol, and that \$50,000 of said amount be added to the aggregate of the town of New Bedford, and \$20,000 to the aggregate of the town of Fall River—and that the tax on polls be fixed at *one mill* each.
