R E S O L V E

Concerning the Boundary Line between Massachusetts and Rhode Island.

Resolved, That the line surveyed and marked by monuments, (by the commissioners appointed, by the States of Massachusetts and Rhode Island, to ascertain and establish the line between said States,) from the monument in Burnt Swamp Corner, so called, in Wrentham, in Massachusetts, to the monument standing between the towns of Thompson, in the State of Connecticut, Burrilville, in the State of Rhode Island, and Douglas, in the State of Massachusetts, as ascertained and established by the commissioners of said States of Massachusetts and Rhode Island, by their joint return to said States, under date of December thirty-first, in the year eighteen hundred and forty-six, be, and the same is hereby, established as the true boundary line between the States of Massachusetts and Rhode Island, from Burnt Swamp Corner, aforesaid, to said monument at the northwest corner of Rhode Island.
