AN ACT

To continue in force the Act to incorporate the Commercial Insurance Company in Nantucket, and to increase its Capital Stock.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 The act to incorporate the Commercial Insurance
2 Company, in Nantucket, passed June seventh, in the
3 year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one,
4 shall be, and remain in force for the term of twenty
5 years from the seventh day of June, in the year one
6 thousand eight hundred and fifty-one; and the said
7 corporation shall be continued through that term,

8 with all the powers and privileges, and subject to all
9 the duties, restrictions and liabilities, set forth in the
10 thirty-seventh and forty-fourth chapters of the Re-
11 vised Statutes, and in all the statutes subsequently
12 passed, relating to insurance companies, and said
13 company is hereby authorized to increase its capital
14 stock, by an addition thereto of a sum not exceeding
15 twenty-five thousand dollars.
