R E S O L V E

Relative to the Removal of Books received from M. Vattemare
to the Boston Athenæum.

Resolved, That the Trustees of the State Library be authorized to deposit such books, maps, and engravings received by international exchanges through M. Vattemare or otherwise, as they may deem least suitable for its purposes, in the library of the Boston Athenæum or in the library of the Natural History Society in Boston, subject to be recalled at pleasure, and to be used under the rules of those institutions by any person having a right to use either of said libraries.
