AMENDMENTS TO SENATE DOCUMENT, No. 105.

Strike out the words in the preamble, "a portion of."

Strike out the first nine lines, and the first five words of line 10, and substitute,—

1 "The dividing line between the towns of Sandisfield
2 and Tolland, is established as follows:—Beginning at
3 the north-west corner of Tolland, at a marked hem-
4 lock, standing on the east bank of the Farmington
5 River, thence running, southerly, along the saide ast
6 bank, at high-water mark, to a stone monument on
7 said east bank, and a short distance north of Hull's
8 Tannery; thence southerly on the west side of the
9 mountain, to a stone monument a short distance south
10 of the house of Elizur Deering; thence, southerly,
11 along the said east bank of said river, at high-water
12 mark, to a marked hemlock, at the south-west corner
13 of said Tolland, on the dividing line of the States of
14 Massachusetts and Connecticut."
