AN ACT

To Set Off a part of the Towns of Chester and Blandford,
and Annex the same to Norwich.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :*

1 SECT. 1. So much of the towns of Chester and
2 Blandford, in the county of Hamden, with the inhab-
3 itants thereon, as lies within the following described
4 line, is hereby set off from said towns of Chester and
5 Blandford, and annexed to the town of Norwich, in
6 the county of Hampshire, to wit: Beginning at the
7 south-west corner of Norwich, at a stone monument

8 in the river at Chester Village, and running thence
9 north six degrees four minutes east in the line between
10 Chester and Norwich six hundred and ninety rods to
11 a point forty-four rods north of the grist mill in Nor-
12 wich known as the Red Mill ; thence south fifty de-
13 grees forty-five minutes west seven hundred and eighty
14 rods to a point in the line between Chester and Bland-
15 ford.

16 Thence south forty-three degrees forty minutes
17 east eight hundred and thirty-five rods and thirteen
18 links to the angle in the line between Blandford and
19 Russell designated by a tree known as "love and
20 unity tree."

21 Thence north twenty-eight degrees forty-one mi-
22 nutes east in the line between Blandford and Russell
23 and Blandford and Montgomery three hundred and
24 seventy-five rods to the corner known as rock-house
25 corner.

26 Thence north seventy degrees west in the line be-
27 tween Blandford and Norwich two hundred and forty
28 rods to the first mentioned bound.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
