AN ACT

To Incorporate the New England Verd Antique Marble
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :*

1 SECT. 1. Thomas W. Gillis, Aaron F. Hughes,
2 Archelaus Wilson, their associates and successors, are
3 hereby made a corporation by the name of the New
4 England Verd Antique Marble Company, for the pur-
5 pose of manufacturing, dressing, setting, and quarry-
6 ing marble. Said Company to be located in the city
7 of Boston, county of Suffolk, with all the powers and
8 privileges, and subject to all the duties, restrictions
9 and liabilities, set forth in the thirty-eighth and forty-
10 fourth chapters of the Revised Statutes.

1 SECT. 2. The said corporation may hold real and
2 personal estate necessary and convenient for the pur-
3 poses aforesaid, not exceeding in amount three hun-
4 dred thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 3. No shares in the capital stock of said
2 corporation shall be issued for a less sum or amount
3 than the par value of the shares which shall first be
4 issued.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
