### AN ACT

To suspend the operation of "An Act giving Equitable Remedies in Suits at Law."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    SECT. 1.   The act passed on the 25th day of May  
2    in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-  
3    three, entitled "An Act giving equitable remedies in  
4    suits at law," is hereby so far amended, and its opera-  
5    tion suspended, that the same shall not take effect  
6    till the first day of March in the year one thousand  
7    eight hundred and fifty-five.

1    SECT. 2.   This act shall take effect from and after  
2    its passage.
