AN ACT

To incorporate the Pacific Mutual Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Edward M. Robinson, Gideon Allen,
2 Benjamin T. Ricketson, their associates and succes-
3 sors, are hereby made a corporation by the name of
4 the Pacific Mutual Insurance Company, to be estab-
5 lished in the city of New Bedford, for the purpose of
6 making insurance against maritime losses; and for
7 that purpose shall have all the powers and privileges,
8 and be subject to all the duties, restrictions and liabil-
9 ities, set forth in the thirty-seventh and forty-fourth
10 chapters of the Revised Statutes, the two hundred and

11 eighty-first chapter of the statutes of the year eighteen
12 hundred and fifty-one, the four hundred and fifty-
13 third chapter of the statutes of the year eighteen hun-
14 dred and fifty-four, and all other acts that have been,
15 or may hereafter be enacted, relating to Mutual In-
16 surance Companies.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
