RESOLVE

In favor of the Town of Berlin.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the school fund of this Commonwealth, to the treasurer of the town of Berlin, the sum of forty dollars and thirty-eight cents, being the amount due said town as their proportion of the school fund for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five, less ten per cent.; and that the governor be authorized to draw his warrant therefor accordingly.
