AN ACT

In relation to the Rights of Children, under Guardian-
ship, to attend the Public Schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. Minors who shall be placed under guar-
2 dianship upon the decease of their father, either
3 pursuant to the general provisions of law, or by the
4 last will of such father, shall be allowed to attend
5 the public schools of the town or city of which such
6 guardian is an inhabitant.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its
2 passage.
