R E S O L V E

On the Petition of Patrick Boise to sell Real Estate.

Resolved, For the reasons set forth in the Petition of Patrick Boise, administrator, that he be, and he is, hereby authorized and empowered, to convey, in fee simple, either by contract or at public auction, the real estate of which Jerusha Phelps, late of Westfield, in the county of Hampden, deceased, died seized and possessed of: *provided, however,* that said Boise shall first give such bond with sureties, to the judge of probate of the county of Hampden, as the said judge shall approve, with condition to pay over the proceeds of said sale to the legal heirs of the said Jerusha Phelps.
