### AN ACT

In addition to an Act to protect the Fishery in Ipswich River, approved February thirteenth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. When any person is found violating the  
2 provisions of the act for the protection of the fish-  
3 eries in Ipswich River, it shall be lawful for any per-  
4 son qualified to make complaint under said act, to  
5 seize and detain, any boat, vessel, or nets, used by  
6 such persons as are found violating said law for the  
7 protection of fishery in Ipswich River, and hold such  
8 boat, vessel, or nets, until the lowest fine named in

9 that act shall be paid, or good and sufficient bond,  
10 with surety, shall be given, to abide the judgment of  
11 the court in that case.

1     SECT. 2. This law shall take effect from and after  
2 its passage.
