### AN ACT

Authorizing the County Commissioners of the County of Essex to lay out and construct a Highway in the Town of Manchester.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1.   The county commissioners of the county  
2 of Essex are hereby authorized and empowered, if,  
3 in their judgment, they deem it expedient, to lay out  
4 an highway in the town of Manchester, commencing  
5 at a point near the depot of the Gloucester Branch  
6 Railroad, crossing said road and the tide-water of the  
7 creek next adjoining said railroad, and also the creek  
8 known as Day's Creek, so called, to some convenient

9 point on the Old Neck, so called. Said commission-  
10 ers, in laying out and constructing said highway, shall  
11 conform to all laws with regard to the laying out of  
12 highways and bridges.

1     SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after  
2 its passage.
