**AN ACT**

In addition to an Act concerning Probate Courts in the  
County of Dukes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives,  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. There shall be a probate court held every  
2 year at West Tisbury, in the county of Dukes, on the  
3 third Monday of October, and at Edgartown, in said  
4 county, on the third Monday of January.

1    SECT. 2. So much of the chapter eighty-three of  
2 the Revised Statutes, as provides for the holding of  
3 probate courts at Tisbury on the third Monday of

4 January, and at Edgartown on the third Monday  
5 of October, is hereby repealed.

1    SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after  
2 its passage.
