## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

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In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Eight.

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### RESOLVE

To provide for the Destruction of certain Cancelled Scrip.

*Resolved*, That the treasurer of this Commonwealth is hereby authorized and directed, in the presence of the auditor, and of any committee of the council who may be appointed for the purpose of witnessing the same, to destroy the scrip or certificates of debt, bearing interest at the rate of five per centum per annum, made by authority of chapter one hundred and thirty-four of the acts of the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four; new scrip bearing interest at the rate of six per centum per annum having been issued in lieu thereof, by authority of chapter two hundred forty-four of the acts of the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven; and said treasurer, auditor and committee, or a major part of them, shall thereupon certify to the fact that said scrip has been destroyed, and their certificate shall be preserved in the office of the treasurer.
