AN ACT

To establish the Compensation of the Lieutenant-Governor
and the Members of the Executive Council.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The compensation of the members of the
2 executive council shall be three hundred dollars each,
3 for the regular annual session of their board held
4 during the session of the legislature in the year for
5 which they shall have been elected, and three dollars
6 for each and every day's attendance at every subse-
7 quent session of said board during their term of office.

1 SECT. 2. The members of said board shall receive
2 two dollars for every ten miles travel, to and from
3 their respective places of abode, once in each session
4 thereof.

1 SECT. 3. The lieutenant-governor shall receive
2 mileage as above provided, and double the compensa-
3 tion provided in the first section of this act for each
4 of the members of the executive council.

1 SECT. 4. The compensation and mileage provided
2 in this act for the lieutenant-governor and members
3 of the executive council, shall be paid at the close of
4 each session of their board.

1 SECT. 5. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 6. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage, and shall apply to the present session of
3 the executive council.
