AN ACT

Relating to the Assessment of Taxes in the Town of Newbury.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 Sect. 1. The assessment of taxes, made by the
- 2 assessors of taxes of the town of Newbury, for the year
- 3 one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five, and the
- 4 taxes, as assessed by said assessors for that year, are
- 5 declared and made legal and valid.
- 1 Sect. 2. No suit at law or in equity hereafter com-
- 2 menced, so far as the cause thereof accrues from any
- 3 irregularity or defect in the assessment of taxes in and
- 4 for said town for said year one thousand eight hun.
- 5 dred and fifty-five, shall be sustained, and this act may

- 6 be shown in bar of any such suit, so far as the cause 7 thereof accrues from any such irregularity or defect.
- 1 Sect. 3. This act shall take effect from and after 2 its passage.
