Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-
Eight.

AN ACT

Making Appropriations to meet certain Expenditures
authorized the present Year.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—*

1 SECT. 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, and shall be allowed and paid out of
3 the treasury of this Commonwealth, from the ordinary
4 revenue, upon the warrants of the governor, for the
5 purposes specified in certain resolves of the present
6 year herein cited, as follows:—

7 In the resolve in favor of the Massachusetts School
8 for Idiotic and Feeble-Minded Youth, in addition to

9 the sum appropriated in chapter eleven of the acts of
10 the present year, two thousand five hundred dollars.

11 In the resolve in favor of the Massachusetts Char-
12 itable Eye and Ear Infirmary, two thousand five hun-
13 dred dollars.

14 In the resolve granting aid for the suppression of
15 counterfeiting bank bills and coin, one thousand five
16 hundred dollars.

17 In the resolve in favor of the State Board of Agri-
18 culture, four thousand dollars.

19 In the resolve relating to the potato rot, a sum not
20 exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars.

21 In the resolve on the petition of Darius A. Martin,
22 a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars.

23 In the resolve in favor of William H. Ela, three
24 thousand five hundred dollars.

25 In the resolve in favor of Albert H. Nelson, late
26 chief justice of the superior court of the county of
27 Suffolk, one thousand seven hundred and thirty-four
28 dollars.

29 In the resolve in relation to the State Industrial
30 School for Girls, four hundred dollars.

31 In the resolve in favor of William Tewksbury,
32 eight hundred dollars.

33 In the resolve on the petition of Alfred Flanders,
34 one hundred and fifty-four dollars and seventy-three
35 cents.

36 In the resolve on the petition of William L. Bemis,
37 fifty dollars.

38 In the resolve on the petition of John McGrath,
39 two hundred and fifty dollars.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
