### AN ACT

Relating to the Charles River and Warren Bridges.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1 The agent of Charles River and Warren Bridges  
2 is hereby authorized to lease, under such conditions  
3 and limitations as the governor and council may  
4 direct, all buildings belonging to the Commonwealth  
5 situated on said bridges: *provided*, that the form  
6 and substance of such lease or leases shall be first  
7 approved by the governor and council, and the same  
8 shall be determinable at their will.
