AN ACT

In addition to an Act to regulate the Fishery in Newbury.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The third section of the one hundred and
2 ninety-fifth chapter of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and thirty-seven, is hereby amended by
4 striking out the words "five dollars" and inserting in

5 place thereof the words one dollar for each fish so
6 taken.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
