**AN ACT**

Relating to Trial Justices.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. Justices of the peace, designated and  
2 commissioned to try criminal cases under the provis-  
3 ions of chapter one hundred and fifty-eight of the  
4 acts of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-eight,  
5 shall have and exercise the powers, authority, and

6 jurisdiction conferred by said act for a term not  
7 exceeding two years from the respective dates of their  
8 said commissions.

1     SECT. 2. All vacancies in the number of said jus-  
2 tices, caused by this act, may be filled in the manner  
3 provided in the act of eighteen hundred and fifty-  
4 eight aforesaid.
