AN ACT

To incorporate the Groton Junction Hotel Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. Abel Prescott, Harvey A. Woods, Levi W.
2 Woods, Stephen Roberts, and Levi W. Phelps, their
3 associates and successors, are hereby made a corpora-
4 tion by the name of the Groton Junction Hotel Com-
5 pany, for the purpose of erecting a hotel in the town
6 of Groton, at Groton Junction, so called, and main-
7 taining such public house, and the buildings and
8 improvements connected therewith; and for these pur-
9 poses shall have all the powers and privileges, and be
10 subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions, set
11 forth in the forty-fourth chapter of the Revised
12 Statutes: *provided*, that said corporation shall not

13 carry on the business of hotel keeping, or be in any
14 way interested in such business.

1 SECT. 2. The whole amount of real and personal
2 estate or capital stock which said corporation may
3 hold for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed
4 fifteen thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
