### AN ACT

Concerning the New Prison in Worcester County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. The county commissioners for the county  
2 of Worcester are hereby authorized to establish the  
3 new prison lately erected by them in the town of  
4 Fitchburg, in said county, as one of the jails and  
5 houses of correction for the use of said county.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on its passage.
