AN ACT

To increase the Capital Stock of the Washington Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 The Washington Insurance Company, in the city
2 of Boston, is hereby authorized to increase its capital
3 stock by an addition thereto of a sum not exceeding
4 one hundred thousand dollars, to be collected and
5 paid in such instalments, and under such provisions
6 and penalties, as the president and directors of such
7 company may appoint.
