AN ACT

To incorporate the Cape Ann Telegraph Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. That Josiah W. Hubbard, William P.
2 Dolliver, Charles Speare, Addison Gott, and Charles
3 Houghton, their associates and successors, be and are
4 hereby constituted a corporation, by the name of the
5 Cape Ann Telegraph Company, with all the rights,

6 powers and privileges, and subject to the restrictions
7 and liabilities contained in the general laws of this
8 Commonwealth relating to corporations established
9 for telegraphic purposes.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized
2 and empowered to construct or purchase, maintain
3 and use lines of telegraph between the city of Boston
4 and Cape Ann, and also a branch of the same to Mar-
5 blehead, and such other branches as may at any time
6 hereafter be deemed expedient by said company.

1 SECT. 3. Said corporation may hold such real and
2 personal estate as may be necessary for the purposes
3 aforesaid, but their whole capital stock shall not
4 exceed fifty thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect from and after
2 its passage.
