AN ACT

Relating to the Compensation of Superintendents of
Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The compensation of superintendents of
2 public schools, as provided for in section thirty-five,
3 chapter thirty-eight, of the General Statutes, shall in
4 no case be less than one dollar and fifty cents for each
5 day of actual service.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from its passage.
