AN ACT

Defining the times of holding the Criminal Terms of the Superior Court for the County of Essex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The terms of the superior court for the
2 transaction of criminal business in the county of
3 Essex, shall be holden at Newburyport, on the second
4 Monday of May; at Lawrence, on the second Monday
5 of October, and at Salem, on the fourth Monday of
6 January.

1 SECT. 2. All writs, processes, bonds and recog-
2 nizances which shall be made returnable to said
3 court, at Salem, on the fourth Monday of October
4 next, shall be returned to be entered at and have
5 day in the term of said court, to be held at Lawrence,
6 on the second Monday of October next.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on the second
2 day of June next.
