AN ACT

Concerning the Smallpox.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 The board of health in the several towns and cities
- 2 shall have power and authority to prohibit persons
- 3 infected with the smallpox or varioloid from going at
- 4 large, and may make such regulations as it deems
- 5 necessary for that purpose.
