### AN ACT

To incorporate the Worcester South-East Agricultural Society.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1     Aaron C. Mayhew, Orison Underwood, B. D.  
2     Godfrey, Henry Chapin, B. Wood, and C. F. Chapin,  
3     their associates and successors, are hereby made a  
4     corporation by the name of the Worcester South-East  
5     Agricultural Society, for the encouragement of agri-  
6     culture and the mechanic arts, by premiums and other  
7     means, in the town of Milford, in the county of  
8     Worcester, for said county of Worcester, and the  
9     counties of Norfolk and Middlesex, with all the pow-  
10    ers and privileges, and subject to all the duties,  
11    liabilities and restrictions, of other agricultural soci-  
12    eties established in this Commonwealth; and said  
13    corporation may hold and manage real estate not  
14    exceeding in value five thousand dollars, and personal  
15    estate not exceeding the same sum for the purposes  
16    aforesaid.
