AN ACT

Relative to Proceedings in Probate Courts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1 The proceedings of any court of probate shall not  
2 be affected by any appeal from any decree or order  
3 thereof hereafter or heretofore made: *provided*, the  
4 court to which such appeal is taken in accordance  
5 with the provisions of law, shall affirm such decree or  
6 order: *and provided*, the proceedings in said court of  
7 probate relative to the matter upon which such decree  
8 or order is made, shall be stayed during the pendency  
9 of such appeal.
